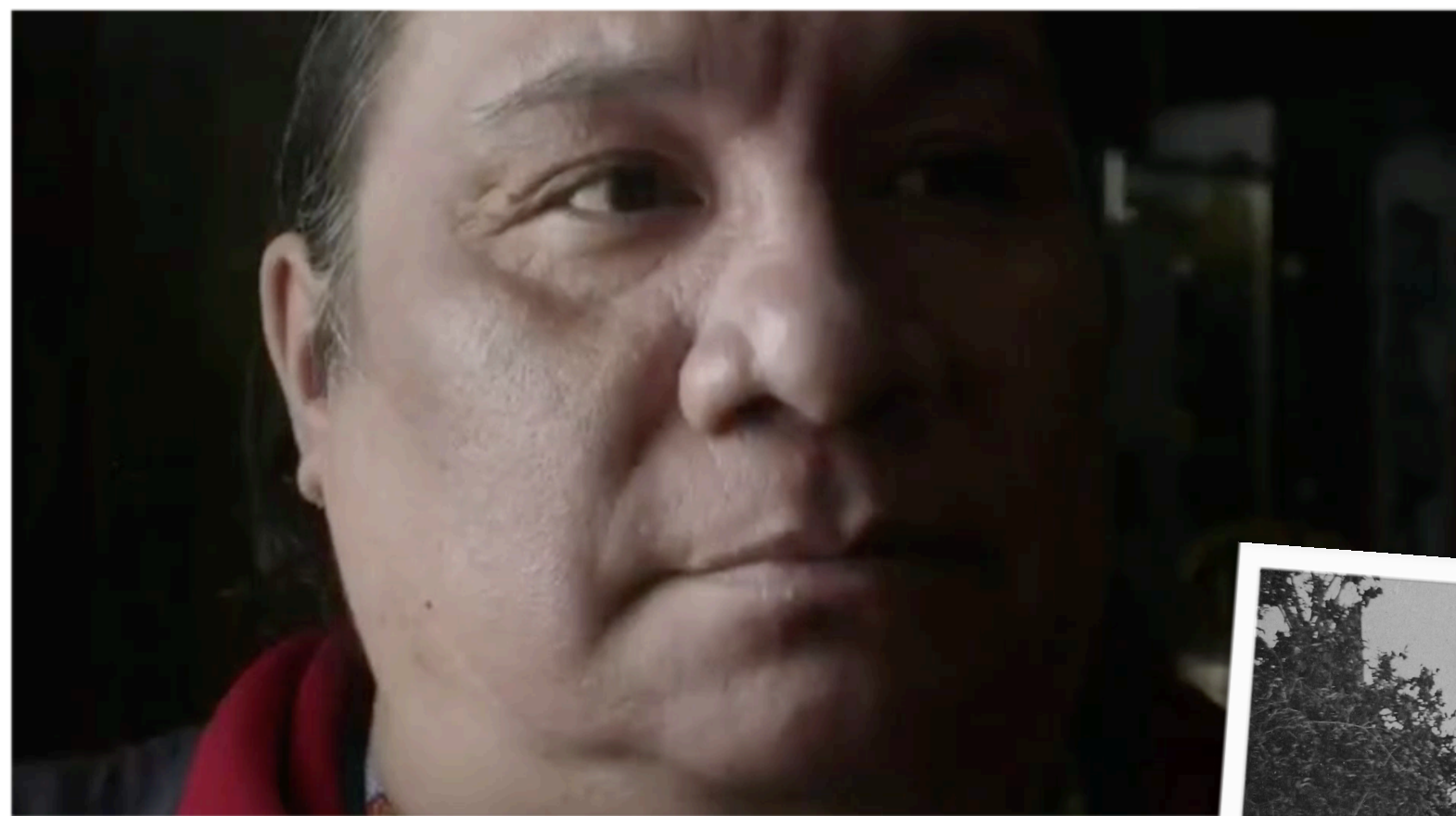
Buffalo
