Lewis and Clark

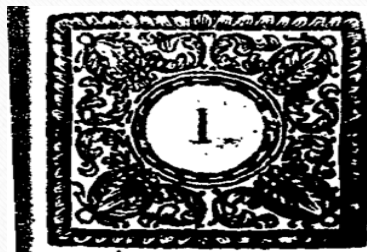
November 11, 1803

11th November - Arrived as Massac engaged George Drewyer in the public service as an Indian Interpreter, contracted to pay him 25 dollards pr. month for his services.— Mr Swan Assistant Military agent at that place advanced him thirty dollars on account of his pay.



Robinson Crusoe



IN the Year, 1632. I was Born at York, of a reputable Family. My Father was a Native of Bremen, who Merchandizing at Hull for some time, gain'd a very plentiful Fortune, and married my Mother in York, who received her first Breath in that Country. And as her Maiden Name was Robinson, I was call'd Robinson

"Oct. 26 - I walked about the shore almost all day, to find out a place to fix my habitation, greatly concerned to secure myself from any attack in the night, either from wild beasts or men.

From the 26th to the 30th I worked very hard in carrying all my goods to my new habitation, though some part of the time it rained exceedingly hard."

...

"I now began to consider seriously my condition, and the circumstances I was reduced to; and I drew up the state of my affairs in writing, not so much to leave them to any that were to come after me [...] as to deliver my thoughts from daily poring over them, and afflicting my mind."

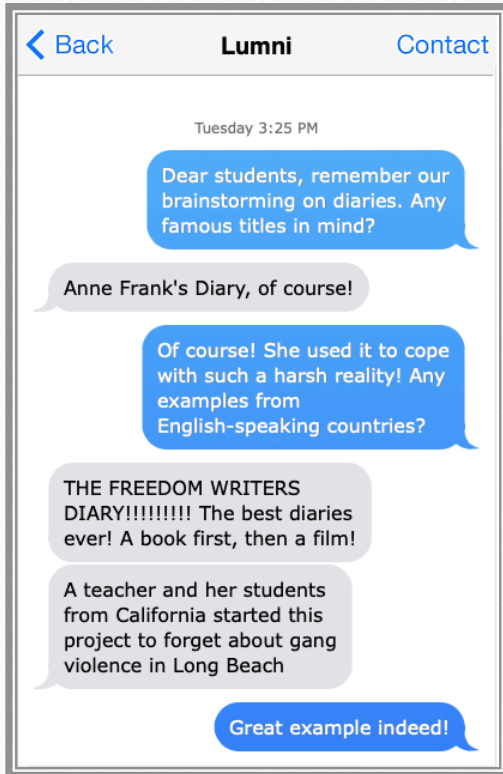


Queen Victoria's diary

Coronation: Thursday, 28 June 1838

I was awake at four o'clock by the guns in the Park, and could not get much sleep afterwards on account of the noise of the people, bands, etc. Got up at 7 feeling strong and well; the Park presented a curious spectacle; crowds of people up to Constitution Hill, soldiers, bands, etc

Direct speech

“Dad, **you need** to leave me alone, **I’m** not a kid anymore!” I said




Indirect speech

I told my dad (that) **he needed** to leave me alone, that I **was** not a kid anymore!

Example of reported speech

Lynda: “**I****m** so happy we get to feature a real author on our show”



Erwan: Lynda said (that) **she** **was** so happy, we got to feature a real author on our show.

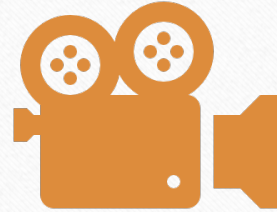
