Let's describe animals....



Guessing game: which animal is it?



It has a furry body and a big tail

It has a very large nose/beak.

It lives and swims in the water .

Guessing game: which animal is it?



It has 4 legs, it's small and it comes from Australia.

It has grey or brown fur.

It has very long claws because it likes to dig tunnels.



Guessing game: which animal is it?



It is generally brown or red and it is furry.

It jumps all the time and moves on 2 or 4 legs.

It has a long tail and it carries its baby in a pouch (pocket).

They have fur, round bodies, fluffy ears, and large oval-shaped noses. Their fur is usually grey or grey-brown in color.

The vast majority of their diet consists of eucalyptus leaves. A single animal usually eats about a pound of leaves in a day. It spends up to 18 hours per day sleeping! They live up in the branches of the trees, rarely climbing down.

Saltwater crocodiles

- Saltwater crocodiles are really big: 6 meters long! They can run and crawl.
- They live in the sea and near rivers in the forest. They lay their eggs in the ground.
- They kill their preys under water.

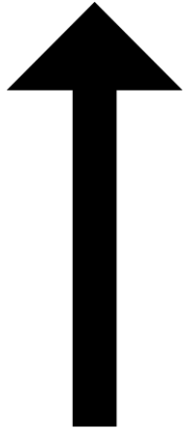

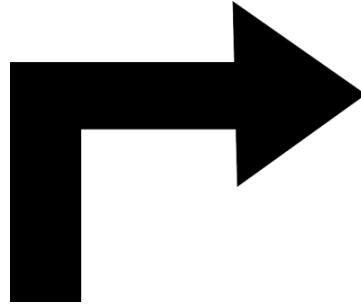

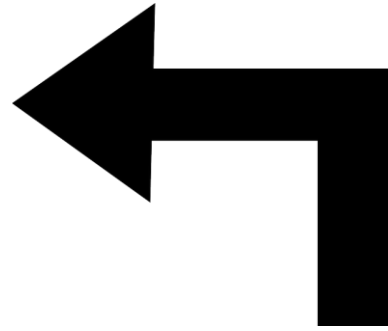
